Profile

Irene gained her Bachelor of Visual Media (Fine Art) degree from Queensland College of Art, Griffith University, Australia, in 2008.

She is a photographer, painter, installation and paper-cutting artist. In December 2011, she set up Flanhardt Galerie und Atelier in Tai O Fishing Village.

Irene has exhibited in various venues including Hong Kong International Airport, Jao Tsung-I Academy, Consulate General of Nepal in Hong Kong, Landmark Atrium, Pacific Place, Taikoo Place, Kai Tak Cruise Terminal and Tai O Heritage Hotel. Her works have been published in numerous notable magazines, newspapers and media websites.

In 2017, Irene curated a multi-media exhibition entitled "Ding Ding to Kowloon" which was a highly successful exhibition where Tram Chasers (founded by Irene) collaborated with Hong Kong Tramways and Jao Tsung-I Academy. The one-month long exhibition attracted over 20,000 visitors and almost 70 social media to cover the event. After the exhibition, Canon invited her to try out a new camera model and hold two seminars and two workshops to talk about her tram project. In 2018 and 2019, she published a book "追蹤電車24小時" (*Following Trams in 24 Hours*) and a photography book "風光背後" (*Behind the Glamour*) respectively.
